

RULES - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

1. Entrance fee for each class, £1.00 per entry, Unlimited entries £10. Children's Classes FREE.

A competitor may enter any number of exhibits in any class.

2. Classes are open to members and non-members alike unless stated otherwise in the schedule.

3. All exhibits to be staged not later than 10.30am on the morning of the Show.

During judging no person except the judges and stewards to be admitted.

4. Exhibitors Entries accepted at the show venue on the Friday night between 7.00pm 9.30pm and on Saturday morning between 8.00am and 10.00am.

5. Exhibits of vegetables, fruit and fresh flowers must have been grown by the exhibitor all pot plants, including cacti and succulents must have been in the possession of the exhibitor for at least 2 months. Fresh flowers to be used in floral art classes.

6. All entries on display at the show must have an Exhibitor's card. Any exhibit without an Exhibitor's card will not be considered for judging.

7. Exhibitors requiring exhibits must remove same between 4.15pm and 4.30pm after which remaining exhibits will be sold and proceeds donated to charity.

8. No exhibits to be removed from the Show bench before 4.15p.m. If you do not wish your exhibit to be sold please label your own exhibit NOT FOR SALE or RESERVED following judging.

9. Plates and vases will be provided by the society for staging the exhibits where appropriate.

10. No responsibility is undertaken by the Society for loss or damage to any article or exhibit.

11. Show opens at 2.00p.m to the Public for viewing and Presentation of A wards at 3.30p.m.

12. In all cases the Judge's decisions to be accepted as final.

13. PRIZES: 1st - £2.00, 2nd - £1.00

14. All trophies are held for one year and should be returned to the Society at least one full month before the next year's show. Engraving is winners' responsibility.

15. Children under 16 attending or entering exhibits at the show must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

16. Due to Health & Safety PLEASE EXERCISE EXTREME CAUTION when using sharp instruments i.e. scissors, knives, etc.

17. All floral art exhibits must be arranged and completed prior to arrival at the show.
